

Fellows' Activity - Insulin Pump Workshop 2020

As part of MEMS's activities for fellows, a half day Insulin Pump Workshop was organized on 8th August 2020 in the auditorium of Hospital Putrajaya. The objective of the workshop was to give participants an exposure to diabetes technologies particularly insulin pump therapy and continuous glucose monitoring system. It was attended by 33 fellows (first to third year) as well as 4 physicians who are due to join endocrine fellowship in October 2020. The workshop was held from 8 am to 1pm and was supported by MEMS and Medtronic Malaysia. 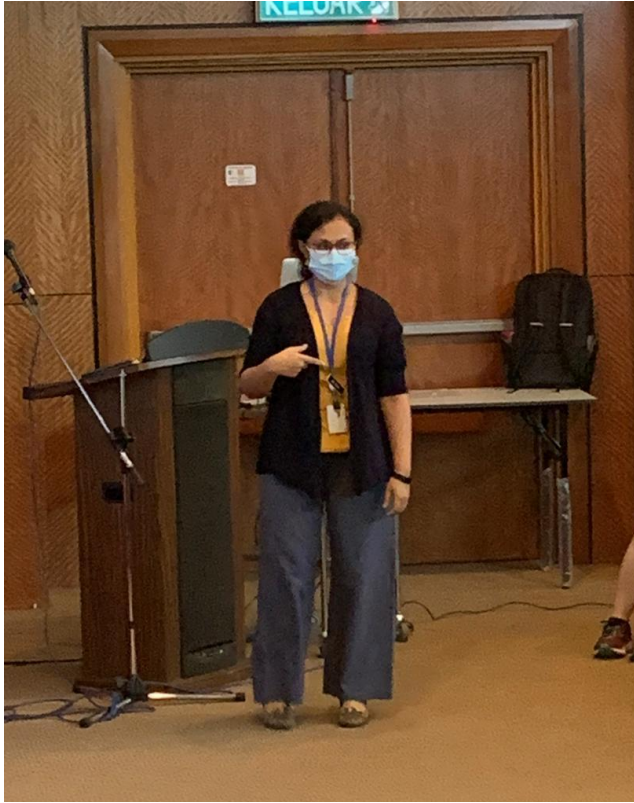
